Cast Studies – Board of Deacons

- 1. Roxanne and John, members of F.P.C. Pleasantville have just experienced a parent's worst nightmare, the loss of a child. How might the FPC Board of Deacons assist the family? How might the Board of Deacons help the congregation with this tragic loss?
- 2. The Covid 19 pandemic has forced the closure of Pleasantville's largest business and both members and non-members of FPC and living in the community have been greatly impacted. The county Food Bank would like to assist the community of Pleasantville with food supplements. As a Deacon at FPC Pleasantville. What would a vision of assistance look like? What process would you consider for this endeavor?
